The Clinic recently celebrated thirteen years of providing free medical care for the poor and uninsured residents of Colonial Beach and Westmoreland County. The Guadalupe Free Clinic, which is an outreach effort of the Catholic Diocese of Arlington, VA, originally opened its doors in May 2005. This grant represents a continuance of the generous support by Mary Washington Hospital dating back to the Clinic's establishment in 2005. It is operated by a small staff and many volunteers who give of their time and talents to provide medical care and prescription medications free of charge to those in need. The Clinic operates on the grounds of St. Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic Church in Colonial Beach and is supported solely by grants and donations from private individuals.
