This grant represents a continuance of the generous support by Mary Washington Hospital dating back to the Clinic's establishment in 2005. It is operated by a small staff and many volunteers who give of their time and talents to provide medical care and prescription medications free of charge to those in need. The Clinic operates on the grounds of St. Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic Church in Colonial Beach. The Guadalupe Free Clinic is supported solely by grants and donations of private individuals.
